Our school – Zespół Szkół Elektrycznych no 1 is a large (educating about 1,100 students) secondary technical school, very conveniently located in the suburbs of one of the most beautiful cities in Poland – Krakow and can boast a 75–year long tradition.

We educate specialists in the field of:

- electronics technician
- automation technician
- electrical technician
- renewable energy technican
- IT technician and programmer

The school puts emphasis on a high level of education and comprehensive development of the student. It tries to respond to the changing needs of the labor market.

A measurable confirmation of the quality of education at ZSE is the annual, almost 100% pass rate of the matura (equivalent of A-levels) exam. Such high results classify our school among the top technical schools in Krakow.

In the nationwide ranking of secondary schools our Electrical and Electronic Technical School ranks among the best vocational schools in the country. The school has been awarded many times with "silver" and "bronze" badges for the high quality of education.

Our students have at disposal well equipped vocational labs, modern complex of sport fields including a football pitch and multifunctional courts, a full-size indoor gymnasium, a table teenis room, a gym, a dormitory with a canteen, a school hall, a computerized library with a reading room, wireless and free internet access at school and dormitory, 24/7 monitoring of the school, a parking lot, green areas (approx. 4 ha).

Our students actively participate in the Małopolska Educational Cloud and in videoconferences and lectures with the participation of technical universities in Krakow, take part in numerous projects carried out within Erasmus+ scheme.

The assumption of carried out projects was that in addition to professional competences, participants should develop key competences, i.e. they know foreign languages, are open and tolerant, can work in a team, are mobile, use modern technologies efficiently and wisely, have a need for learning and selfdevelopment and are aware of the shared European identity. These competences are extremely important in modern labour market, which is reflected in the analyzes of graduates' career paths. Through the implementation of this project, the school is also to support intercultural understanding and thus counter radicalisation, unfortunately observed among young people, also in our school, by showing common European values.
